

Notice of Changes in Rates for Water Services

At United Water we work hard to provide you with top quality water and service in the most cost effective manner. In order to maintain compliance with increasingly stringent water quality standards, the company must invest in its facilities which purify and deliver your drinking water.

On August 4, 2010, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities approved a rate increase for United Water New Jersey customers which was primarily related to water quality improvements at our Haworth Water Treatment Plant and investments in our water distribution system.

As a result, the typical residential customer will see an average increase in their water bill of \$3.19 a month or 10 cents a day.

The \$100 million upgrade to the Haworth Water Treatment Plant uses the most advanced technologies to improve water quality, safeguard the environment and enhance overall performance. The new upgrades will help United Water:

- Meet increasingly stringent water quality regulations
- Deliver better tasting, higher quality drinking water
- Reduce chemical usage
- Improve water quality in the Oradell Reservoir
- Maintain wetlands and other environmentally sensitive areas

Today's filing includes capital improvements made since April:

- Haworth & Other Water Treatment Plant Improvements \$ 50.0 million
- Transmission & Distribution System Upgrades \$ 10.6 million
- Meters, Hydrants & Services \$ 8.1 million
- Other General Plant Investments \$ 11.9 million
