

## Notice of Changes in Rates for Water Services

At United Water we work hard to provide you with top quality water and service in the most cost effective manner. In order to maintain compliance with increasingly stringent water quality standards, the company must invest in its facilities which purify and deliver your drinking water.

On June 7, 2010, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (NJBPU) approved an increase in water rates for residential and commercial customers of United Water Toms River, South Toms River and Berkeley. The typical residential customer, using an average of 5,300 gallons of water per month, will see an average bill increase of \$6.67 a month or approximately 22 cents per day. The increase was primarily related to water quality improvements at the Holly Water Treatment Plant in Toms River and the Berkeley Water Treatment Plant in Berkeley Township as well as inflationary impacts on overall operating expenses. These new rates are effective in accordance with NJBPU Docket No. WR09110934.

A full breakdown of your new service charges is included in this leaflet.
